

**VI. A sampling of expulsions of Jesuits from various nations** (hopefully listed chronologically according to the 1<sup>st</sup> year of expulsion by various nations; in some cases the monarch who ordered the expulsion is listed):

- (1) 1579 – Elizabeth I, Queen of England
- (2) 1614 – Japan
- (3) 1618 – the Kingdom of Bohemia
- (4) 1716, 1783 – China
- (5) 1719 – Peter the Great of Russia
- (6) 1759 – King Joseph I of Portugal
- (7) 1764 – King Louis XV of France
- (8) 1816 – Russian Czar Alexander I [He expelled the Jesuits from Moscow and St. Petersburg.]
- (9) 1820 – Russian Czar Alexander I [He expelled the Jesuits from all of Russia.]
- (10) 1820, 1835, 1868 – Spain
- (11) 1834 – Portugal [2<sup>nd</sup> expulsion of the Jesuits from Portugal]
- (12) 1848, 1859 – Italy
- (13) 1848 – Switzerland
- (14) 1872 – Guatemala
- (15) 1872 – German-Prussian Empire
- (16) 1873 – Mexico
- (17) 1874 – Brazil
- (18) 1875 – Ecuador and Columbia
- (19) 1880, 1901 – France [2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> expulsions of the Jesuits from France]
- (20) 1884 – Costa Rica
- (21) 1901 – Portugal [3<sup>rd</sup> expulsion of the Jesuits from Portugal]
