Our mailbox is really full this issue. So many people have written us with questions and comments as a result of the 2002 campaigns. We couldn't possibly put them all in, but here are some of the more interesting ones. We always welcome your comments and opinions, and try whenever possible to reply. So, keep them coming!

Dr. Veith: First, thank you for sharing your time and knowledge in your stay in Tulsa. You helped me to make some important connections as well as enlightened me on details of several subjects I have been studying for some years. Also, due to your talks, I have begun to eat healthier and rely less on supplements. Second, I was surging on the net and found the Loma Linda University website which had a bioethics masters. Since that is a field I am interested in (I'm a philosophy student at Oklahoma State University that had plenty of questions for you in Tulsa), I asked for more information. The tuition is way out of my budget, but I noticed that on the envelope, as well as

on their magazine and all other documents, they had a "seal". This seal is made up of different pagan symbols not just one or two - but seven that I count! They are: the torch, a serpent around a rod or staff, a partial pic of a sword with Ellen White's death year next to it, a laurel branch, a yoni or goddess symbol with the upside down triangle - all on a shield with a ribbon underneath. There is also a different branch with an acorn - I'm not sure of its symbolism. Then there is writing in so that the entire shield with branches on either side are contained with a nice circle. Now the ribbon is EXACT to the ribbon of masonry/paganism, the shield, etc. And these are multiple symbols of masonry/paganism - not just one or two. Could you please help me to understand how this "seal" is any different from the Catholic, masonic, etc seals/symbols - and what on earth is it doing on a university seal which is a Seventh-Day Adventist university which is also prominent on their literature. Dear D.W.

This is a very very good question. Isn't it interesting how far the tentacles can stretch? Some of these symbols could sneak into logos by ignorance, such as the medical symbol of the rod and serpent which of course has a pagan origin. Then, of course, the possibilities exist that there are more sinister motives behind some of these symbols. The Seventh-day Adventist Church is not officially associated with the World Council of Churches, and its structure, theoretically at least, is management from the bottom up, which is unlike any other system. So the power is in the hands of the members, and not in the hierarchy. Isaiah 9 says that God will cut off the head and the tail - the head being the

prominent people, and the tail - the prophets that speak lies. The Bible also says that the wheat and the tares grow together until the harvest. Gold will cleanse His church through the shaking because the Bible says the Lord will once more "shake" His institution. So, wherever we study, we will have to filter that which we learn through the greatest filter on earth - the Word of God. when man had reached one of its lowest ebbs. There was great evidence of disease, demonic activity, and superstition as evidenced in the gospels. He came to uplift fallen humanity and he met them where they were. The Son of Man came eating and drinking within the boundaries of the Mosaic Law, of course. Q: The supplement to National Geographic Feb 2002 issue mentions c. 12,000 feet long ice core samples which have been drilled near Russia's Vostok Station. These contain each year's accumulation of snowfall including the dust particles, chemicals and gases which have been trapped in the flakes. By analysing the samples scientists have concluded that they represent a period of 420,000 years. Have you got an alternative explanation for their age? E.H.

Dear E.H.: Just as in the case of Varves, which are so-called annual mud deposits in lakes, which give supposed ages of 100's of thousands of years, so the ice layers are similar to these. Varves have bene recently shown to not represent annual events, but episodic events. For example, some leaves are buried in up to 80 layers of varves, which would mean that the leaf survived 80 years while waiting to be buried. So now, it is accepted, that varves represent any event such as a rainstorm. Similarly, the layers of snow need not be annual, but episodic. Also, areas in Siberia which are covered in huge frozen mud deposits with no apparent source for these muds, which also contain the bones of woolly mammoths and temperate climate adapted creatures show that these immense layers were catastrophic.

My dear friend:

*I have followed the exact op*posite route to what you are describing. I was an evolutionist, an atheist, and taught evolution at the university for 25 years. All the socalled scientific evidence turns out to be a pile of potash as shown in my series. There is a perfectly local solution for the environmental features that we find which are perfectly in harmony with the Scriptures and totally out of harmony with the evolutionary paradigm.

#1: If evolution is correct, we must start with a small number of creatures and through diversity get more and more. The fossil record shows the reverse. We start with large numbers and go less and less. The Cambrian explosion - a scientific term by the way - shows that all the phyla appeared simultaneously, totally out of harmony with evolutionary con-

Q: Would you please offer any insight on the subject of the structured SDA church vs. the independent movement? I would greatly appreciate your point of view. L.H.

Dear L.H.: The structure SDA church

has its origin in prophecy. It was foretold in the book of Revelation 10 that it would arise out of a great disappointment after the close of the 1260 days (ie. 1798), that it would keep the commandments of God, and hold to the testimony of Jesus which si the Spirit of Prophecy. Through the Spirit of Prophecy, church structure was established. And it is this organization which is to stand till the close of time. WE are also informed that in the final analysis, the church will be Laodicea. This has prompted many movements to separate themselves from the body in order to reflect a purer light of present truth. However, there is no "coming out" of Laodicea - no admonition that the candlestick would be removed. There is only a "spitting out" (a shaking) where GOD removes what needs to be removed. A "coming out" before the time is thus premature and unBiblical. Yes, there will be weeping between the porch and the altar for all the evil that is done in Israel, but God will do the cleansing.

The king of north is the papacy, and the time of the end spoken about there when the king of the south shall push against them, is a reference to the inflicting of the mor-

tal wound - or the seemingly mortal wound rather - when secular humanism will seem to temporarily dethrone this power. This took place in 1798 with the French Revolution. However, in the secret societies, it is taught that this system (humanism) was set up in order to create an atheistic diversion which would be overcome together with Christianity to give the papacy full rule over the world. A Double Portion

The Seventh-day Adventist Church is identified in Revelation 10 as the remnant entrusted with the final message of warning to the world. Having been established out of all denominations, this final movement was to be grounded in no other creed than that of the Bible and the Bible alone. The pillars of eternal Truth were established through Bible study and the Spirit of Prophecy and these pillars were to stand until the end of time. That which was discerned as truth in the beginning would remain truth throughout eternity.

Let that therefore abide in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father. 1 John 2:24

The twin pillars of faith in the Word of God and obedience to His precepts have always been distorted because Satan is determined to sell a half gospel whereby one can be saved by Christ without the manifestation of obedience or one can live an obedient life without the saving grace of Christ. Planned volunteer-informant corps elicits '1984' fears

As part of the country's war against terrorism, the Bush administration by next month wants to recruit a million letter carriers, utility workers and others whose jobs allow them access to private homes into a contingent of organized government informants. The Terrorism Information and Prevention System (Operation TIPS), a national reporting pilot program, is scheduled to start next month in 10 cities, with 1 million informants - or nearly 4 percent of Americans - initially participating in the program.

The program will allow volunteers, whose routines make them well-positioned to recognize suspect activities, to report the same to the Justice Department, which is running the project. The Justice Department will enter the information into a database, which will then be broadly available within the department, and to state and local agencies and local police forces. At local and state lev-

Our Faith Founded on Truth

"I long daily to be able to do double duty. I have been pleading with the Lord for strength and wisdom to reproduce the writings of the witnesses who were confirmed in the faith and in the early history of the message. After the passing of the time in 1844 they received the light and walked in the light, and when the men claiming to have new light would come in with their wonderful messages regarding various points of Scripture, we had, through the moving of the Holy Spirit, testimonies right to the point, which cut off the influence of such messages...When the power of God testifies as to what is truth, that truth is to stand forever as the truth. No after suppositions contrary to the light God has given are to be entertained. Men will arise with interpretations of Scripture which are to them truth, but which are not truth. The truth for this time God has given us as a foundation for our faith. He Himself has taught us what is truth. One will arise, and still another, with new light, which contradicts the light that God has given under the demonstration of His Holy Spirit. ... And the standard bearers who have fallen in death are to speak through the reprinting of their writings. I am instructed that thus their voices are to be heard. They are to bear their testimony as to what constitutes the truth for this time. We are not to receive the words of those who come with a message that contradicts the special points of our faith. They gather together a mass of Scripture, and pile it as proof around their asserted theories. This has been done over and over again during the past fifty years. And while the

Scriptures are God's word, and are to be respected, the application of them, if such application moves one pillar from the foundation that God has sustained these fifty years, is a great mistake. He who makes such an application knows not the wonderful demonstration of the Holy Spirit that gave power and force to the past messages that have come to the people of God." - 1 SM p.160-161

The burden of the warning now to come to the people of God, nigh and afar off, is the third angel's message. And those who are seeking to understand this message will not be led by the Lord to make an application of the Word that will undermine the foundation and remove the pillars of the faith that has made Seventh-day Adventists what they are today. The truths that have been unfolding in their order, as we have advanced along the line of prophecy revealed in the Word of God, are truth, sacred, eternal truth today. Those who passed over the ground step by step in the past history of our experience, seeing the chain of truth in the prophecies, were prepared to accept and obey every ray of light. They were praying, fasting, searching, digging for the truth as for hidden treasures, and the Holy Spirit, we know, was teaching and guiding us. Many theories were advanced, bearing a semblance of truth, but so mingled with misinterpreted and misapplied scriptures, that they led to dangerous errors. Very well do we know how every point of truth was established, and the seal set upon it by the Holy Spirit of God. And all the time voices were heard, "Here is the truth," "I have the truth; follow me." But the warnings came, "Go not ye after them. I have not sent them, but they ran." (See Jeremiah 23:21) The leadings of the Lord were marked, and most wonderful were His revelations of what is truth. Point after point was established by the Lord God of heaven. That which was truth then, is truth today. But the

Elijah is the type of the end-time Elijah. His message was a message of separation from paganistic influences to the wholehearted service of God. Elijah confronted the king of Israel and the prophets of Baal and exposed their religious forms for what they were. - -fire consumed the offering of Elijah in response to his sincere prayer,
- -Elijah's prayer brought rain,
- -twice the captains of 50 were consumed by fire,
- -and the Jordan parted.

Elijah called Elisha from the plow and Elisha is the one who diligently served his master, being willing to perform the menial tasks while he was being prepared for greater things. Three times Elisha was given the opportunity to leave the side of his master, but three times he refused. Elijah was visiting the school of the prophets, and Elijah said to Elisha: "Stay here please because the Lord has sent me to Bethel". 2 Kings 2:2 But Elisha said, "As the Lord lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you." The sons of the prophets had been informed that Elijah would be taken away by the Lord and Elisha clung to the side of the prophet of the Lord. In verse 4, a further opportunity was given, but again Elisha answered, "As the Lord lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you." The same thing happens a third time (verse 6). After his final visitation to the school of the prophets, Elijah was about to depart to be translated to heaven. In verse 9, he asks Elisha "What may I do for you before I am taken away from you?" Elisha said, "Please let a double portion of your spirit be upon me." Elijah replied, "You have asked a hard thing. Nevertheless, if you see me when I am taken from you, it shall be so for you."

Elisha saw how Elijah was taken up to heaven and when he took up the mantel, he became the representative who would nurture and establish Israel. Those who live at the end of time, are types of Elisha, but they are inseparately bound to Elijah and refuse to leave that which was entrusted to them. "Surely as the Lord lives, I will cling to the Elijah message – the pillars of the Advent message." When Elisha put on the mantel of Elijah, as we have to put on the mantel of the Elijah message, the Lord honored his request for a double portion. And in order to stand at the end of time, we will need a double portion of the Spirit of Elijah. Elisha's miracles were

more than double those recorded for Elijah:

- 1) He struck the water and it was divided. In the same way, insurmountable obstacles will be overcome by those who trust in the Lord and have the Spirit of Elisha. 2 Kings 2:14
- 2) He cleansed the waters with salt and the bitter water became sweet. In the same way, we are to be the salt of the earth and turn the bitter waters of compromise and lies into

4) The next miracle was the water that filled the valley by the way of Edom. (2 Kings 3:17) The waters that filled the valley of Edom to supply the needs of the army of Israel, so even in the absence of rain, God

is able to supply our needs.

- 5) Elisha also is credited with the miracle of the jar of oil that did not run dry until all the vessels that could be filled were filled. In the same way, God's people at the end of time will not run out of the Spirit of God until all the vessels that can be filled are filled to the brim. 2 Kings 4:2
- **6)** He promised the Shunammite woman that she would bear a son. *2 Kings 4:31*
- 7) And when that son died, God honored his request and raised him to life again. 2 Kings 4:34-35
- 8) When there was famine in the land and the men from the school of the prophets had added poisonous gourds to their stew, Elisha ordered them to add flour which cleansed the meal. This same power is available to God's people at the end of time. 2 Kings 4:38
- 9) He multiplied loaves of barley to feed the men 2 Kings 4:42 10) He commanded Namaan to immerse himself in the Jordan seven times to be cured of his leprosy and he was cured. 2 Kings 5:1-14

- 11) His servant Gehazi became leprous as a consequence of his greed. 2 Kings 5:20
- 12) He made the axe float when the students of the school of the prophets were expanding their dwellings. 2 Kings 6:5
- 13) And many times, he confounded the enemies of Israel by revealing their most secret plans. 2 Kings 6:9
- 14) When surrounded by the enemy, he prayed that his servant's eyes might be opened so that he may realize that "those that are with us are more than those that are with them." This is vital to those who stand in the breach at the end of time. 2 Kings 6:17
- 15) He prayed for blindness upon his enemies 2 Kings 6:1816) He prayed for the removal of blindness of his enemies.
- 17) He cause the army of the Syrians to hear the noise of chariots and horses so that they fled before their attackers 2 Kings 7:6
- **18)** He pronounced a famine which was to last seven years (2 Kings 8:1), a double portion. Elijah's famine lasted only three and a half years.

Those living at the end of time, like Elisha, will be present when the Lord puts an end to the harlot. Jezebel was destroyed in the time of Elisha. It is Elisha who serves as the type of the remnant of the remnant. But he is inseparably linked to Elijah and will not leave nor forsake the ancient landmarks. It is for this reason that we read in the Spirit of Prophecy that the ancient landmarks of the founding fathers are faithfully recorded and will stand until the end of time. There is no separation from the Elijah message, but to meet the crisis at the end of time, God will pour out more than a double portion of the Spirit of Elijah upon those who faithfully follow the Lamb wheresoever He goeth.

Both Elijah and Elisha were diligent in communicating the message of hope not only to the outside world, but also to the schools of the prophets. At these schools, students were taught the law of God, the natural sciences in such a way that they would harmonize with the Word of God. They studied the scriptures, sacred history, sacred music, poetry, agriculture and horticulture.

"Further provision was made for the instruction of the young, by the establishment of the "school of the prophets." If a youth was eager to obtain a better knowledge of the Scriptures, to search deeper into the mysteries of the kingdom of God, and to seek wisdom from above, that he might become a teacher in Israel, this school was open to him."

"By Samuel the schools of the prophets were established to serve as a barrier against the widespread corruption resulting from the iniquitous course of Eli's sons, and to promote the moral and spiritual welfare of the people. These schools proved a great blessing to Israel, promoting that righteousness which exalteth a nation, and furnishing it with men qualified to act, in the fear of God, as leaders and counselors. In the accomplish-

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ment of this object, Samuel gathered companies of young men who were pious, intelligent and studious. These were called the sons of the prophets. The instructors were men not only versed in divine truth, but those who had themselves enjoyed communion with God, and had received the special endowment of His Spirit. They enjoyed the respect and confidence of the people, both for learning and piety.

"The pupils of these schools sustained themselves by their own labor as husbandmen and mechanics. In Israel this was not considered strange or degrading; it was regarded a crime to allow children to grow up in ignorance of useful labor. In obedience to the command of God, every child was taught some trade, even though he was to be educated for holy office. Many of the religious teachers supported themselves by manual labor. Even so late as the time of Christ, it was not considered anything degrading that Paul and Aquila earned a livelihood by their labor as tentmakers.

"The chief subjects of study were the law of God with the instructions given to Moses, sacred history, sacred music, and poetry. It was the grand object of all study to learn the will of God and the duties of His people. In the records of sacred history were traced the footsteps of Jehovah. From the events of the past were drawn lessons of instruction for the future. The great truths set forth by the types and shadows of the Mosaic law were brought to view, and faith grasped the central object of all that system, the Lamb of God that was to take away the sins of the world.

"The Hebrew language was cultivated as the most sacred tongue in the world. A spirit of devotion was cherished. Not only were students taught the duty of prayer, but they were taught how to pray, how to approach their Creator, how to exercise faith in Him, and how to understand and obey the teachings of His Spirit. Sanctified intellects brought forth from the treasure house of God things new and old.

The art of sacred melody was diligently cultivated. No frivolous waltz was heard, nor flippant song that should extol man and divert the attention from God; but sacred, solemn psalms of praise to the Creator, exalting His name and recounting His wondrous works. Thus music was made to serve a holy purpose, to lift the thoughts to that which was pure and noble and elevating, and to awaken in the soul devotion and gratitude to God. FE 96-97

Misuse of the school of the prophets and compromise with the world reached a point where God could not work through these institutions any longer, and by the time of John the Baptist, the Lord did not send this servant of His to the school of the prophets. Neither were the disciples educated in the school of the prophets.

"John was called to do a special work; he was to

prepare the way of the Lord, to make straight His paths. The Lord did not send him to the school of the prophets and rabbis. He took him away from the assemblies of men to the desert, that he might learn of nature and nature's God. God did not desire him to have the mold of the priests and rulers. He was called to do a special work. The Lord gave him his message. Did he go to the priests and rulers and ask if he might proclaim this message?—No, God put him away from them that he might not be influenced by their spirit and teaching. He was the voice of one crying in the wilderness, "Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain; and the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it" (Isa. 40:3-5). This is the very message that must be given to our people; we are near the end of time, and the message is, Clear the King's highway; gather out the stones; raise up a standard for the people. The people must be awakened. It is no time now to cry peace and safety. We are exhorted to "cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and shew my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins" (Isa. 5:1). 1SM 410.1

"As soon as the passover was finished, the brethren left Jerusalem, and went to Galilee as they had been directed. Seven of the disciples were in company; they were clad in the humble garb of fishermen; they were poor in worldly goods, but rich in the knowledge and practice of the truth, which gave them, in the sight of Heaven, the highest rank as teachers. They had not been students in the school of the prophets, but for three years they had taken lessons from the greatest educator the world has ever known. Under his tuition they had become elevated, intelligent, and refined, fit mediums through which the souls of men might be led to a knowledge of the truth." 3SP 226.1

Sadly, many of our institutes have followed the same route and have compromised their practices and teachings to be in line with what is taught in the world. Evolution is taught as an acceptable theory of origins, worldly theologians are preferred above a "thus saith the Lord". Those that would hold up standards are often ridiculed, but even here there is need of caution, as some would separate from Elijah and claim some form of superiority. Moses did not separate from the children of Israel when the Lord told him that he would make a new nation out of him. But he pleaded that he should rather be blotted from the book of life, rather than them. This should be our attitude.

Nevertheless, we need to train men and women to stand in the time we are living, and to present this message to the world. We need to establish institutes even if on a small scale,

where men and women can learn to win souls and to learn the things as taught in the school of the prophets. We need to separate from worldly practices. We need to introduce reverence and godly music into the minds of men and learn afresh how to worship God in the beauty of holiness.

"Let every one now do his duty, laboring actively with Jesus Christ. Represent Jesus by your example of Christian piety, that the grace of Christ may appear as it is,—beautiful, attractive, harmonious, and always consistent. A life beauti-

fied with holiness is not a life of idle contemplation; but a life filled up with earnest work for the Master, whose light shineth more and more unto the perfect day. As Seventh-day Adventists, we have a work to do in witnessing for Christ. If indeed the Lord is coming, it is time to sell what you have and give alms. It is time to put out your money to the "exchangers", time to place every dollar you can spare, into the treasury of the

> works will appear as a proof of this agent in the soul. You should redouble your efforts, redouble your working forces." GCB, October 1, 1896 par. 9

> Young men and women are crying out for solid food and if only we could re-organize the forces of the Lord so that the workers can receive faithful instruction. These institutions are to be established in rural areas with land for cultivation and should not be elaborate or be left to one man to dominate the teaching.

> "True missionary workers will not colonize. God's people are to be pilgrims and strangers

on the earth. The investment of large sums of money in the building up of the work in one place is not in the order of God. Plants are to be made in many places. Schools and sanitariums are to be established in places where there is now nothing to represent the truth. These interests are not to be established for the purpose of making money, but for the purpose of spreading the truth. Land should be secured at a distance from the cities, on which schools can be built up, and where the youth can be instructed in agricultural and mechanical lines of work. ..." 11MR 155.3

"What can I say to our people that will lead them to follow the course that will be for the present and future good? Will not those in Battle Creek heed the light given them by God? Will they not deny self, lift the cross, and follow Jesus? Will they not obey the call of their Leader to leave Battle Creek and build up interests in other places? As he was crossing a bridge he fell from his horse and was killed. But in the country the youth are away from the sights and the sounds of the city. We desire to take the students away from the foul atmosphere of the city. Not that Satan is not here. He is here, but we are trying to do all we can to place the students in the very best circumstance in order that they may fasten their eyes on Christ...Those who present the truth should be men of solid minds, who will not lead their hearers into a field of thistles, as it were, and there leave

They may have had years of training, and yet [may] not have touched the very beginning, the ABC of spirituality, the ABC of devotion, the ABC of self-sacrifice. Elisha, by careful, patient instruction, must endeavor to guide Israel in safe paths. His association with Elijah, the greatest prophet since the days of Moses, prepared him for the work that he was soon to take up alone.

"During these years of united ministry, Elijah from time to time was called upon to meet flagrant evils with stern rebuke. When wicked Ahab seized Naboth's vineyard, it was the voice of Elijah that prophesied his doom and the doom of all his house. And when Ahaziah, after the death of his father Ahab, turned from the living God to Baal-zebub, the god of Ekron, it was Elijah's voice that was heard once more in earnest protest.

"The schools of the prophets, established by Samuel, had fallen into decay during the years of Israel's apostasy. Elijah re-established these schools, making provision for young men to gain an education that would lead them to magnify the law and make it honorable. Three of these schools, one at Gilgal, one at Bethel, and one at Jericho, are mentioned in the record. Just before Elijah was taken to heaven, he and Elisha visited these centers of training. The lessons that the prophet of God had given them on former visits, he now repeated. Especially did he instruct them concerning their high privilege of loyally maintaining their allegiance to the God of heaven. He also impressed upon their minds the importance of letting simplicity mark every feature of their education. Only in this way could they receive the mold of heaven and go forth to work in the ways of the Lord. {PK 224.3} The heart of Elijah was cheered as he saw what was being accomplished by means of these schools. The work of reformation was not complete, but he could see throughout the kingdom a verification of the word of the Lord, "Yet I have left Me seven thousand in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed unto Baal."

1 Kings 19:18, PK 224, 225

"In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise."

If we are faithful in this work, God will pour out his Spirit, and the latter rain will fall. The Elijah message will be preached with a double portion and there will be a repetition of Pentecost.

"The great work of the gospel is not to close with less manifestation of the power of God than marked its opening. The prophecies which were fulfilled in the outpouring of the former rain at the opening of the gospel, are again to be fulfilled in the latter rain at its close. . . .

"Servants of God, with their faces lighted up and shining with holy consecration, will hasten from place to place to proclaim the message from heaven. By thousands of voices, all over the earth, the warning will be given. Miracles will be wrought, the sick will be healed, and signs and wonders will follow the believers.—*GC* 611, 612 (1911).

God will employ agencies that will surprise us.

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means that will be suitable, and will maintain, increase, and build up His own people.—CW 71 (1895).

"The Comforter is to reveal Himself, not in any specified, precise way that man may mark out, but in the order of God in unexpected times and ways that will honor His own name.— EGW'88 1478 (1896).

"He will raise up from among the common people men and women to do His work, even as of old He called fishermen to be His disciples. There will soon be an awakening that will surprise many. Those who do not realize the necessity of what is to be done will be passed by, and the heavenly messengers will work with those who are called the common people, fitting them to carry the truth to many places.—15MR 312 (1905)

The body of Christ is to remain united. The object and aim is not the separate from Israel but to nurture Israel. We are not to call God's people Babylon and isolate ourselves, but we are to faithfully guard the ancient waymarks and labour with our brothers and sisters. We are our brother's keeper.

"The Lord holds the church responsible for the souls whom they might save. If his people were to see themselves as God sees them, they could not endure to look their responsibilities and delinquencies in the face. Self-reproach would overwhelm them. Brethren and sisters in the faith, does the question arise in your hearts, "Am I my brother's keeper?" If you claim to be the children of God, you are your brother's keeper. God has entrusted to you sacred truths. Christ abiding in the individual members of the church is a well of water, springing up into everlasting life. You are guilty before God if you do not make every effort possible to dispense this living water to others. Men are perishing close by your own doors, while they hew out to themselves broken cisterns that hold no water. Heaven is indignant at the ease of men and women in Zion, while souls are going down to ruin in their ignorance and sins. Have we the truth for these last days? If we have, it must be carried to every nation, kindred, tongue, and people. Ere long, the living and the dead will have been judged according to the deeds done in the body, and the law of God is the standard by which they are to be tested. Of this they must now be warned. God's holy law must be vindicated, and held up before them as a mirror. RH, October 12, 1886 par. 11

It is time that we labour together on these issues and put our money into the Lord's treasury to support this type of work.

"But this work requires means. It is true that times are hard, that money is not plenty; but the truth must be spread, and money to spread it must be placed in the treasury. Many are

trembling with fear because the work moves faster than their slow faith, and means is expended more rapidly than it comes into the treasury; and yet we have taken only the first few steps in advance. Our message is world-wide; yet many are doing nothing, and many more, so very little, and with so great a want of faith, that it is next to nothing. Shall we abandon the field that has already been opened in foreign countries? Shall we drop part of the work in our home missions? Shall we be disheartened at a debt of a few thousand dollars? Shall we falter and become laggards in the very last scenes of this world's history? My heart says, No, no! I cannot contemplate this question without a burning zeal in my souls to see this work go. We would not deny our faith, we would not deny Christ; yet we shall commit this fearful sin unless we move forward, as the providence of God opens the way. The work must not stop for want of means. More money must be invested. "Sell that ye have and give alms." There is a time coming when commandment-keepers can neither buy nor sell. In the last extremity, before this work shall close, thousands of dollars will be cheerfully laid upon the altar. Men and women will feel it a blessed privilege to share in the great work of preparing souls to stand in the great day of God, and they will give hundreds as readily as five dollars are given now. But let us not dishonor God by thinking that the church has not the means to do all the work that devolves upon her just now." RH, October 12, 1886 par. 12



MARANATHA MEDICAL MINISTRIES - Joe & Elsa Willis are Seventh-day Adventist medical missionaries working in the Carribean and Central America. Through several circumstances in their lives, they felt that God was calling them to do a special work for Him. Leaving their home in Virginia, they have established an outpost through God's providence in the mountains of Honduras, where they treat the "forgotten poor" - those that have no money for hospital or medical care and therefore, are left to suffer and die. Several days every week they have "visitation day" where the surrounding community comes for medical treatment and a little extra kindness. As a result of their work in Honduras, there is now a little church built in the mountains with 10 baptized members and 13 more waiting for baptism. Joe & Elsa Willis do not want to keep this experience only for themselves. They open their outpost to anyone who would like to come and experience the life of a medical missionary and learn how to do some of the same things they are doing, including homeschool and school groups. Many people have already come to their outpost to help. Among them a young girl, named Sheri Trueblood, who has spent 6 months with them in the Honduras mountains, learning about natural remedies and medical techniques, as well as learning Spanish and teaching the little children and giving Bible studies.

Joe, Elsa, and Sheri have been on tour in the US for the summer, sharing their experiences with video footage and telling of the people in the mountains. On July 5-7, 2002 they presented their experiences at the Langley SDA Church. It was a pleasure to hear their stories and "meeting" the people they have helped. One of their stories that they shared was moving account of a little boy named "Juan".

Juan was a little 8 year old boy that had to pick coffee

beans every day to help feed his family. In the evenings, he liked to attend the children's meetings that were being held congruent to an evangelistic seminar for the adults. As the series continued, Joe & Elsa realized that the adults attending needed to have their own Bibles. Although there were no Bibles available, they saved up money until they could go and buy some Bibles, but it was specifically stated that the Bibles would go only to the adults. Juan desperately wanted a Bible of his own, and so he repeatedly asked if he couldn't possibly also get a Bible. After much pleading, Joe & Elsa decided that they would make an exception and save Juan a Bible when the Bibles arrived. Each day, Juan would run to the children's meetings and ask "Are they here yet? Have the Bibles arrived?" and each day he would be told, "No, Juan, the Bibles haven't come yet."

But one day, the Bibles did arrive. The girls teaching the children's class were excited as they wrote a little note to Juan in his new Bible. They looked forward to that evening when they could present him with his very own Bible. That day it had rained heavily, and the hillside was covered in rivers of mud. When evening came, the girls waited expectantly for Juan to arrive, but Juan did not arrive. Soon they began to wonder why he wasn't coming, but then they saw him, coming from the coffee bean fields. He was very muddy from the day's work and the results of the heavy rains. As he came in, they called him over to them, and smiling, held out the beautiful Bible that Juan had so long been wanting. But instead of taking the Bible, Juan backed off and with a pained expression, said "No, I can't take it!" "Why not?" the girls asked, surprised at this sudden change. "Because I'm too dirty", said Juan. "I can't take it."

This story, which was told to the children at Langley SDA Church, had a lesson in it for all of us. How do we treat the Holy Word? Do we treasure it, keeping it clean, placing it carefully, never covering it with another book of "lesser" quality? And how do we approach it when we read it? Do we realize how dirty we too are? Do we ask Jesus to cleanse us each and every day of our sin and from all unrighteousness? Perhaps we would have a richer experience with the Lord, and a closer walk with Him, if we realized our real state more often, instead of bolstering ourselves up in self-confidence. Just a thought.

Eating Between Meals The Importance of Regularity

... After the regular meal is eaten, the stomach should be allowed to rest for five hours. Not a particle of food should be introduced into the stomach till the next meal. In this interval, the stomach will perform its work, and will then be in a condition to receive more food.

...In no case should the meals be irregular. If dinner is eaten an hour or two before the usual time, the stomach is unprepared for the new burden; for it has not yet disposed of the food eaten at the previous meal, and has not vital force for new work. Thus the whole system is overtaxed.

... neither should the meals be delayed one or two hours, to suit circumstances, or in order that a certain amount of work may be accomplished. The stomach calls for food at the same time it is accustomed to received it. If that time is delayed, the vitality of the system is decreased, and finally reaches so low an ebb that the appetite is entirely gone. If food is then taken, the stomach is unable to properly care for it. The food cannot be converted into good blood.

... If all would eat at regular periods, not tasting anything between meals, they would be ready for their meals, and would find a pleasure in eating that would repay them for their effort.

... Regularity in eating is of vital importance. There should be a specified time for each meal. At this time, let every one eat what the system requires, and then take nothing more until the next meal. There are many who eat when the system needs no food, at irregular intervals, and between meals, because they have not sufficient strength of will to resist inclination. When travelling, some are constantly nibbling if anything eatable is within their reach. This is very injurious. If travellers would eat regularly of food that is simple and nutritious, they would not feel so great weariness, nor suffer so much from sickness.

...Regularity in eating should be carefully observed. Nothing should be eaten between meals, no confectionery, nuts, fruits, or food of any kind. Irregularities in eating decrease the healthful tone of the digestive organs, to the detriment of health and cheerfulness. And when the children come to the table, they do not relish wholesome food; their appetites crave that which is hurtful for them.

...Children are generally untaught in regard to the importance of when, how, and what they should eat. They are permitted to indulge their tastes freely, to eat at all hours, to

help themselves to fruit when it tempts their eyes, and this, with the pie, cake, bread and butter, and sweetmeats eaten almost constantly, makes them gormands and dyspeptics. The digestive organs, like a mill which is continually kept running, become enfeebled. Vital force is called from the brain to aid the stomach in its overwork, and thus the mental powers are weakened. The unnatural stimulation and wear of the vital forces make them nervous, impatient of restraint, self-willed, and irritable.

...It is quite a common custom with people of the world to eat three times a day, besides eating at irregular intervals between meals; and the last meal is generally the most heartiest and is often taken just before retiring. This is reversing the natural order; a hearty meal should never be taken so late in the day. Should these persons change their practice to eat but two meals a day, and nothing between meals, not even an apple, a nut, or any bite of fruit, the result would be seen in a good appetite and greatly improved health.

... Three meals a day and nothing between meals not even an apple - should be the utmost limit of indulgence. Those who go further violate nature's laws and will suffer the penalty.

Getting the Pork Out

The Bible tells us that swine (pork) is an unclean food (*Lev. 11:7*). God also told His people, "Their flesh you shall not eat, and their carcasses you shall not touch. They are unclean to you." (*Lev 11:8*) "Therefore come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you." (*2 Cor 6:17*)

"Pork, although one of the most common articles of diet, is one of the most injurious. God did not prohibit the Hebrews from eating swine's flesh merely to show His authority, but because it was not a proper article of food for man. It would fill the system with scrofula, and especially in that warm climate produced leprosy, and diseases of various kinds. Its influence upon the system in that climate was far more injurious than in a colder climate. But God never designed the swine to be eaten under any circumstances... But it is not the physical health alone which is injured by pork eating. The mind is affected, and the finer sensibilities are blunted by the se of this gross article of food. It is impossible for the flesh of any living creatures to be healthy when filth is their natural element, and when they will feed upon every detestable thing. The flesh of swine is composed of what they eat. If human beings eat their flesh, their blood and their flesh will be corrupted by impurities conveyed to them through the swine." Counsel on Diet and Foods, p. 392-3

Do you know what foods pork is found in? You might be surprised! While it's easy to avoid pork chops, ham and bacon, few of us realize how clever the food industry is in adding pork to our diets in the form of gelatin.

Gelatin - Where Does It come From?

Currently gelatin is manufactured from collagen derived from animal carcasses. Leiner Davis Gelatine (Davenport, Iowa) claims they have the largest gelatin manufacturing plant in the northern hemisphere. Their website (www.gelatin.com) states that they use the skin of pork and beef to make gelatin. Gelatine Manufacturers of Europe (www.gelatine.org) claims they also use the bones of these animals.



Prions in Gelatin?

The FDA has recently raised concerns about the safety of gelatin as a food product in light of the spread of mad cow disease. ² Gelatin is manufactured at low temperatures (less than 200 F) while it takes a temperature of 800 F to destroy the prion that causes mad cow disease. The mad cow disease prion is found most commonly in the central nervous system and the bones of animals. Nerve tissue reaches all parts of the body, including the skin, and the butchering process slices the bone and smears its contents across the face of the cut produced. So there is no safety in being selective about the parts you eat, if you choose to eat meat at all. It only takes one prion to start trouble. Scientists have observed that a prion placed next to a normal protein will change the normal protein to a prion. They have also discovered by studying vCJD disease cases from Britain that it only takes 18 months for symptoms of mad cow disease to show up in humans who have eaten infected beef. 3.

What is it Used in?

Gelatin is used in a variety of ways by the food industries, as a gelling agent, thickener, film former, protective colloid, adhesive agent, stabilizer, emulsifier, foaming/whipping agent, and a beverage fining agent, according to Leiner Davis Gelatin. Another website states that gelatin is used in hard capsules, soft gels, plasma expanders, tablet binders and coatings, and vaccine stabilizers as well as numerous consumer food applications. ⁴ The Gelatine Manufacturers of Europe website also indicates the major food use sectors for gelatin are jelly, bakery, meat products, fish products, confectionary, ice cream, alcoholic and soft drinks, dairy products, and yellow fats and spreads.

So general speaking, gelatin may be an ingredient in any processed food product on the market today, especially those with a gooey, chewy consistency or requiring thickeners and gravies. They are often listed as mono- and di-glycerides on nutrition labels. A visit to the website of Leiner Davis Gelatin provided a wide list of foods in which gelatin is a component.

<u>Confectionery products:</u> gelled confectionery - includes jubes, wine gums, pastilles and the popular gummy products; aerated confections - marshmallows, nougate, marshmallow-meringues, and biscuit and wafer fillings; sugar-pulled confectionery - fruit chews, milk caramels, toffees, cream pastes, licorice; compressed tablets; lozenges

<u>Dairy products:</u> yogurt, sour cream, soft cheese products (cream cheese, cottage cheese and cheese spreads), acidic

milk desserts (frozen and refrigerated cheesecakes), flavored milk-based desserts (puddings, molded creams and custards, mousses, chiffons and souffles), frozen desserts (premium ice-cream to water-ices, milk ices and novelties), thickened cream, low-fat butters/spreads (margarine products)

Gelatin Desserts - jelly crystals or tablets such as in "Jell-O" and rennet

Meat Products - cooked ham, canned meat products, aspics (aspics are diced and seasoned cooked meat or meat and vegetable pieces suspended in a gel made of gelatin), sausage, decorative jellies, coatings and glazes for meats

Farinaceous Foods - biscuit marshmallow, frostings and icings, bakery glazes

Other Applications - as a binder and gelling agent in canned seafood and seafood aspic products; micro-encapsulation of flavors, colors and vitamins; as a stabilizer in cream fillings for frozen baked products; protein enrichment of foods such as in beverages and dietetic products; as a film former in panned confectionery products such as sugared almonds, hard panned chewing gum varieties and also in the coating of fruits, meats and delicatessen items; as a thickener and emulsifier in soups, sauces, and gravies; in combination with other hydrocolloids, gelatin can also be used as a thickener and stabilizer in low fat mayonnaise and salad dressings.

The Bottom Line

If you want to avoid pork in your food, avoid eating commercially manufactured foods. Make your prepared dishes yourself. Make them from whole grains you cook yourself, legumes you prepare yourself, fresh/frozen vegetables, fresh fruits, and raw nuts and seeds you roast yourself. Obtain your sweeteners from dates, raisins, honey, applesauce (the kind made of apples and water only), and jams/jellies/ apple "butters" made from 100% fruit without additives. (Pectin and citric acid are okay; they come from fruits). If you must add gravies or thickeners, make your own from flower, water or nut milks, olive oil and herbs. Nut creams, nut milks and tofu work well as replacements for milk and milk products in gravies and sauces. Many dishes can be prepared ahead of time and placed in the freezer for quick use.

If you feel it's too hard to make your favorite dishes "from scratch" try changing your menu plan. The palate can be trained to enjoy simple foods from natural sources, and your body will be healthier for it. Nutritionists today advocate eating a diet of whole grains, vegetables, fruits and nuts.

Eliminate sugary desserts, commercially prepared cookies, and candy from your diet. Replace them with fresh fruit but avoid eating fruits and vegetables at the same meal. (See The Health Message, vol. 1 no. 7) Eat healthy and stay health!

Cashew Cream

2/3 c cooked rice warm ½ C cashews, unsalted 1 tsp vanilla

½ tspsalt

3-4 tsp honey

1/4 - 1/2 cup water - just enough to blend the ingredients for a thick consistency

1 med banana (use only if using cream for dessert-type recipes)

In a blender, combine all ingredients and blend on high speed until smooth and creamy. It may take 2-3 minutes for the cashews to be thoroughly blended. Then add more water, a little at a time, until desired consistency is reached. Add as little water as possible to make a thick cream base for soups, gravies, and other recipes that need thickening. Leave out the vanilla and the honey when using in soups. Chill in an airtight container. Makes 21/2 cups of cream. This can be made up to 3 days ahead of time and stored in an airtight container. For milk, use 3-4 cups of water.

Operation TIPS is one part of President Bush's new volunteer Citizen Corps program that urges Americans to keep their neighborhoods safe. The program is described on the government Web site www.citizencorps.gov.

"This broad network of volunteer efforts will harness the power of the American people by relying on their individual skills and interests to prepare local communities to effectively prevent and respond to the threats of terrorism, crime, or any kind of disaster," the program's description on the Web site states.

The program has already alarmed several civil liberties groups, including the American Civil Liberties Union and the Rutherford Institute, which say the administration should not allow TIPS to become "an end run around the Constitution."

Critics say that having Americans act as "domestic informants" is reminiscent of the infamous Stasi, the newdisbanded communist East German secret police service that snooped on dissidents and ordinary East German citizens for more than 40 years, compiling a huge catalogue of notes.

Rachel King, an ACLU legislative counsel, said yesterday the organization is concerned that law enforcement will use the volunteers, especially those whose occupations allow them to enter homes and monitor residents - to search people's residences, without a warrant. She said that the organization is also worried that the program will adversely affect the fight against terrorism by wasting resources on useless tips and that the program will encourage vigilantism and racial profiling.

"The administration apparently wants to implement a program that will turn local cable or gas or electrical technicians into government-sanctioned peeping Toms," Miss King said.

John Whitehead, executive director of the Rutherford Institute, agreed.

"This is George Orwell's '1984.' It's an absolutely horrible and very dangerous idea," he said. "It's making Americans into government snoops. President Bush wants the average American to do what the FBI should be doing. In the end, though, nothing is going to prevent terrorists from crashing planes into buildings."

A Justice Department official in charge of answering questions about Operation TIPS was out of the office yesterday and not available for comment.

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GOD'S **ULTIMATUM**

The last words of our loving Lord to His church were not the great commission - "Go ye there-

fore..." Matthew 28:19,20. While it is true this is indeed to be our work until the close of probation, nevertheless. Christ's last words to the church was "Repent"! This was His command to five of the seven churches in Asia and the fact is that this ration still stands. Five out of seven Christians and churches today need, first of all, to repent. God's ultimatum is "Repent or else". Revelations 2:5,16

Repentance is a much frowned on word today in 21st century religion, but it was an indispensable word in New Testament theology. John the Baptist, we are told in Mark 1:1-4, was the first to preach the gospel in preparing the way of the Lord. His message was that of repentance. (See also Matthew 3:1,2) In Mark 1:14,15 we read the same of Jesus. Again in Luke 13:3 He said, "...except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish."

The problem today, I believe, with 21st century sophisticated society can be summed up in the experience of the evangelist who asked a man, "Are you saved?" and the man replied, "No, but I'd like to be". "Is it because you realize that you're a sinner?" asked the minister. "Well, of course, we're all sinners!" was his reply. "But are you a sinner yourself?" the evangelist pressed. "Well, I suppose I am, but not what you'd call a bad sinner. In fact, I think I'm a fairly good person – as good as the average, at least!" "Then," replied the evangelist thoughtfully, "as long as you feel that way, there is little I can do to help you find the way to salvation. Good sinners, along with truthful liars, honest thieves and upright scoundrels are far from being ready to accept of the proffered grace of God.. This grace is for the poor, unworthy sinner with no goodness to plead and no personal merit to build upon. God can help and save only one who is ready to be saved by the works and merits of another. That one is the Lord Jesus Christ, I appeal to you to repent and seek Him with your whole heart." Whether he did or not, I do not know.

The problem we face today, not only in the world but in the church, is that so many "good sinners" call themselves Christians, but they have never taken the first step in finding the peace and joy in Christ Jesus that He declares is essential. (Luke 13:3)

Whether we are overt sinners, never having given our hearts to the Lord, or halting, failing, defeated saints,

there is only one way to God. We must repent. We must come

to Jesus in full and complete surrender. falling, as it were, upon the Rock, Christ Jesus, and be broken. We've got to spill it all out to Him. This is not easy for 21st century, proud hearted men and women.

Many people do not understand the word "repentance". They are like the young man who came to evangelist D.L. Moody to discuss the subject of repentance. "It never struck me," he declared."What do you mean?" Moody asked."Well," the youth replied, "Some it strikes and some it doesn't. I've seen many repent and take their stand for Christ, but it has never struck me."This young man had the mistaken idea that repentance is something like lightning. This is not true. We are moved to re-

pentance, but repentance is not emotion. It's a deep conviction of wrong doing that leads the individual to turn to God for cleansing from sin. The Greek word for repentance is "metanoeo" which means "to change one's mind". Repentance is a gift from God, and like all gifts, it can be rejected or we can choose to receive it and act upon it.

Repentance and confession are inseparable. Those who accept the gift of repentance will confess their sins and "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness". 1 John 1:9 When we do this we are justified, which means now we stand before God "just as if" we never committed a sin in our lives and if we are "justified by faith, then we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ". (See Romans 5:1) That's not only good news about something to happen in the sweet by and by, but it's a joyful experience that one can have here and now. Praise God!

The reason Jesus said, "Repent or else!" which may seem rather harsh to some, is because it's one of His loving gifts that He so freely gives to whosoever will and is the first step in our acceptance of Him who is the only means of salvation. Most people think of repentance as something that we do when we get ourselves into trouble and it's our guilt that drives us to repentance rather than the "goodness of God". (Romans 2:4) We read in Matthew 11:20 that Jesus accused the cities wherein most of His mighty works were done because they repented not. Why did He do that? Because it says that in these cities most of His mighty works were done and if you read verse 5 of chapter 20 it tells us all the wonderful miracles He performed for them and still they repented not. Repentance is too often motivated by the things we do. While it is true we need to repent of our sins when we do wrong, Jesus not only forgives us our sins but He delivers us from the power of sin. How is this made possible? There is only one way. We must be born again, born from above. There has to be a power working from within. We read about it in Ezekiel 36:26,27: "A new heart

"You will be in constant peril (danger) until you understand the true force of the will. You may believe and promise all things, but your promises or your faith are of no value until you put your will on the side of faith and action. Your feelings, your impressions, your emotions, are not to be trusted, for they are not reliable, especially with your perverted ideas; and the knowledge of your broken promises and your forfeited pledges weakens your confidence in yourself, and the faith of others in you.

"But you need not despair. You must be determined to believe, although nothing seems true and real to you. You must win back your confidence in God and in your brethren. It is for you to yield up your will to the will of Jesus Christ; and as you do this God will immediately take possession, and work in you to will and to do of His good pleasure. Your whole nature will then be brought under the control of the Spirit of Christ; and even your thoughts will be subject to Him.

"You cannot control your impulses, your emotions as you may desire, but you can control the will, and you can make an entire change in your life. By yielding up your will to Christ, your life will be hid with Christ in God and allied to the power which is above all principalities and powers." MYP 151, 152

"Pure religion has to do with the will. The will is the governing power in the nature of man, bringing all the other faculties under its sway. The will is not the taste or the inclination, but it is the deciding power, which works in the children of men unto obedience to God, or unto disobedience." MYP 151

Notice what it says here in the book Thoughts From the Mount of Blessing, p 62, about what happens when we surrender our will to the Lord. This is most encouraging be-

cause it shows us the miracle of grace that takes place when we surrender our will to the Lord. This is something that we cannot do for ourselves. Our part is to surrender.

"Our will is to be yielded to Him, that we may receive it again, purified and refined, and so linked in sympathy with the Divine that He can pour through us the tides of His love and power. However bitter and painful this surrender may appear to the willful, wayward heart, yet "it is profitable for thee." MB 62

When we have this experience we are automatically doing His will and this is when it becomes a joy to be a Christian. Our will is one with His will! Praise God!!

Notice what Desire of Ages page 466 says of this experience:

"In the work of redemption there is no compulsion. No external force is employed. Under the influence of the Spirit of God, man is left free to choose whom he will serve.....The expulsion of sin is the act of the soul itself. True, we have no power to free ourselves from Satan's control; but when we desire to be set free from sin, and in our great need cry out for a power out of and above ourselves, the powers of the soul are imbued with the divine energy of the Holy Spirit, and they obey the dictates of the will in fulfilling the will of God."

Then on page 668 of the same book we read:

"All true obedience comes from the heart. It was heart work with Christ. And if we consent, He will so identify Himself with our thoughts and aims, so blend our hearts and minds into conformity to His will, that when obeying Him we shall be but carrying out our own impulses. The will, refined and sanctified, will find its highest delight in doing His service. When we know God as it is our privilege to know Him, our life will be a life of continual obedience. Through an appreciation of the character of Christ, through communion with God, sin will become hateful to us".

"It is through the will that sin retains its hold upon us. The surrender of the will is represented as plucking out the eye or cutting off the hand. Often it seems to us that to surrender the will to God is to consent to go through life maimed or crippled." MB 61

"Only through the surrender of our will to God is it possible for Him to impart life to us. Only by receiving His life through self-surrender is it possible, said Jesus, for these hidden sins, which I have pointed out, to be overcome." MB 61

"If you cling to self, refusing to yield your will to God, you are choosing death. To sin, wherever found, God is a consuming fire. If you choose sin, and refuse to separate from it, the presence of God, which consumes sin, must consume you." MB 62

Steps to Christ, page 49 speaks of surrender.

"Many are inquiring, 'How am I to make the surrender of myself to God?' You desire to give yourself to Him, but you are weak in moral power, in slavery to doubt, and controlled by the habits of your life of sin. Your promises and resolutions are like ropes of sand. You cannot control your thoughts, your impulses, your affections. The knowledge of your broken promises and forfeited pledges weakens your confidence in your own sincerity, and causes you to feel that God cannot accept you; but you need not despair. What you need to understand is the true force of the will. This is the governing power in the nature of man, the power of decision, or of choice. Everything depends on the right action of the will. The power of choice God has given to men; it is theirs to exercise. You cannot change your heart, you cannot of yourself give to God its affections; but you can choose to serve Him. You can give Him your will; He will then work in you to will and to do according to His good pleasure. Thus your whole nature will be brought under the control of the Spirit of Christ; your affections will be centered upon Him, your thoughts will be in harmony with Him.

"Desires for goodness and holiness are right as far as they go; but if you stop here, they will avail nothing. Many will be lost while hoping and desiring to be Christians. They do not come to the point of yielding the will to God. They do not now choose to be Christians."

So right now why not pray and ask the dear Lord to take your will and sanctify it, and purify it. Say, "Dear Lord, please help me and change me from the inside out. I choose to surrender my will to you now. I choose to be fully surrendered.

"Through the right exercise of the will, an entire change may be made in your life. By yielding up your will to Christ, you ally yourself with the power

that is above all principalities and powers. You will have strength from above to hold you steadfast, and thus through constant surrender to God you will be enabled to live the new life, even the life of faith." SC 49

Isn't this wonderful? But there is something even more beautiful. Thoughts from the Mount of Blessing, p. 60

"When the thought of evil is loved and cherished, however secretly, said Jesus, it shows that sin still reigns in the heart. The soul is still in the gall of bitterness and in the bond of iniquity. He who finds pleasure in dwelling upon scenes of impurity, who indulges the evil thought, the lustful look, may behold in the open sin, with its burden of shame and heartbreaking grief, the true nature of the evil which he has hidden in the chambers of the soul. The season of temptation, under which it may be, one falls into grievous sin, does not create the evil that is revealed, but only develops or makes manifest that which was hidden and latent in the heart. As a man "thinketh in his heart, so is he;" for out of the heart "are the issues of life." Proverbs 23:7;4:23.

"No one can occupy a neutral position; there is no middle class, who neither love God nor serve the enemy of righteousness. Christ is to live in His human agents and work through their faculties and act through their capabilities. Their will must

be submitted to His will; they must act with His Spirit. Then it is no more they that live, but Christ that lives in them. He who does not give himself wholly to God is under the control of another power, listening to another voice, whose suggestions are of an entirely different character......"

"The strongest bulwark of vice in our world is not the iniquitous life of the abandoned sinner or the degraded outcast; it is that life which otherwise appears virtuous, honorable, and noble, but in which one sin is fostered, one vice indulged. To the soul that is struggling in secret against some giant temptation, trembling upon the very verge of the precipice, such an example is one of the most powerful enticements to sin." *MB 94*.

Do you want to be such a person? I think not. I certainly don't.

"As the will of man co-operates with the will of God, it becomes omnipotent. Whatever is to be done at His command, may be accomplished in His strength. All His biddings are enabling!" MYP 101

"But you must remember that your will is the spring of all your actions. This will, that forms so important a factor in the character of man, was at the fall given into the control of Satan; and he has ever since been working in man to will and to do of his own pleasure, but to the utter ruin and misery of man....

"There is no such thing as following Christ unless you refuse to gratify inclination and determine to obey God. It is not your feelings, your emotions that make you a child of God, but the doing of God's will. A life of usefulness is before you, if your will becomes God's will." MYP 153, 154

"A noble all-round character is not inherited. It does not come to us by accident. A noble character is earned by individual effort through the merits and grace of Christ. God gives the talents, the powers of the mind; we form the character. It is formed by hard, stern battles with self. Conflict after conflict must be waged against hereditary tendencies. We shall

have to criticize ourselves closely, and allow not one unfavorable trait to remain uncorrected.

"Let no one say, I cannot remedy my defects of character. If you come to this decision, you will certainly fail of obtaining everlasting life. The impossibility lies in your own will. If you will not, then you cannot overcome. The real difficulty arises from the corruption of an unsanctified heart, and an unwillingness to submit to the control of God." MYP 99

"The sense of sins forgiven will bring that peace that passeth all understanding. There will be an earnest striving to overcome all that is opposed to Christian perfection. Variance will disappear. He who once found fault with those around him will see that far greater faults exist in his own character." MYP 73

Are you beginning to see the truth in the words of Jesus, "Repent or else."? We have somuch to repent of. The fact is He's coming soon and real soon. He's coming for His bride, and "The bride has made herself ready". *Rev.19:7* Are you ready, am I ready? That's the question that should concern each and every one of us.

When Jesus came the first time He entered by way of a seed in Mary's womb and no one saw Him come. The next time He comes, "Every eye shall see Him."!

The first time He came as a Lamb. The next time He is coming as the Lion of the tribe of Judah.

The first time He came to redeem. The next time He's coming to rule and to reign.

The first time He came to die. The next time He's coming to raise the sleeping saints.

The first time He wore a crown of thorns. The next time He will be wearing a golden crown of glory. (*Rev. 14:14; Matt. 16:27*)

Let me sum it all up by quoting a very familiar text to all of us I am sure:

"It shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh....And it shall come to pass that whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be delivered." *Joel 2: 28-32*

"It shall come to pass afterward...". —After what? What will precede the great outpouring of the Spirit of God that He has promised in these last days? We find the answer in the same chapter verses 12 and 13, God is speaking, and He says, "Turn ye even to me with all your heart,...and rend your heart, and not your garments." This is a call for genuine repentance.

My appeal is that we take seriously the call of our Savior, "Repent or else". May God bless us all to this end.
