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

nen the mark of the beast has been universally enforced, and all the world gives homage to the beast, Satan's masterpiece in this world will have been perfected. And the great harlot of Revelation will be confident that she has once again regained her lost supremacy which was taken away when the Protestant reformation inflicted the deadly wound. Revelation 18:7 depicts her as chanting to herself, "I sit a gueen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow." And to all appearances she's 'got the whole world in her hands'. Satan also rejoices that he is now receiving almost universal homage through the homage given to the great harlot. But from the sanctuary, there emerges a 'fit man' that is going to challenge Satan and his allies in their attempt to exercise complete dominion over planet earth.

When the loud cry has done its work and all the faithful souls are called out of Babylon, Christ's ministry in the sanctuary will come to a close. The investigative judgment will be finished, the sanctuary will have been cleansed from the sins of God's people. Then it is that the final sequel will take place, as prefigured in the day of atonement

ceremony in ancient Israel, which brings the 'fit man' on the world stage. Leviticus 16:20-22 describes this event:

"And when he hath made an end of reconciling the holy place, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat: And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all

their transgressions of all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness."

Let us consider what is signified by the leading away of the scapegoat and who is the 'fit man' that leads him into the wilderness to die. We have some good indication as to when the scapegoat is being led away. In the ancient ritual service, this happened immediately after the high priest had completed his work in the most holy

place, as we noted in Leviticus 16 quoted above. The inspired commentary on this passage states it thus: "Every case was decided, every jewel numbered. Jesus tarried a moment in the outer apartment of the heavenly sanctuary, and the sins which had been confessed while He was in the most holy place were placed upon Satan, the originator of sin, who must suffer their punishment." EW 280

It is interesting to note that only the sins that were confessed while Jesus was in the most holy place were placed upon the scapegoat at this point. The sins of those who died before 1844 will be placed upon Satan when Christ resurrects His sleeping saints at His second coming. There is a special reason for this which we will see later. The question facing us at this point is 'Who is the fit man?'

We know from the scriptural account that he wasn't the high priest, nor is there any mention of him being a priest at all. He apparently was a man of the congregation who obviously had just participated in the solemn service of the day of atonement and received its benefits. Then who might this 'fit man' represent in the anti-type?

It does not seem logical to expect the symbolism of the fit man to apply to from the sanctuary, there one individual. Rather, it is more reaemerges a 'fit man' that is sonable to consider the fit man as repgoing to challenge Satan resenting the last community of sealed and his allies in their atsaints who have experienced the bentempt to exercise complete efits of Acts 3:19, which is the day of dominion over planet earth. atonement experience. It will be their sins, along with those who died under

> the giving of the Three Angel's Messages, that will be placed upon Satan at this point. The work of God's people is depicted in the book of Revelation by angels carrying out the divine commission. In Revelation 14 we see three angels representing God's people, giving to the world the last message from heaven. Similarly, in Revelation 18 we see God's people, represented by a mighty angel, proclaiming the loud cry message and calling all the faithful souls out of Babylon. Then in Revelation 20, we see vet another angel who lays hold of the dragon, the antitypical scapegoat, and binds him with a great chain before his ultimate destruction. This angel fits very well into the sym-

bolism of the fit man who emerges from the day of atonement service at the sanctuary to take hold of the scapegoat and lead him away to his ultimate death. Inspiration gives us an interesting insight into this episode.

"I saw that Jesus' work in the sanctuary will soon be finished. And after His work there is finished, He will come to the door of the first apartment, and confess the sins of Israel upon the head of the Scape Goat. Then He will put on the garments of vengeance. Then the plagues will come upon the wicked, and they do not come till Jesus puts on that garment, and takes His place upon the great white cloud. Then while the plagues are falling, the Scape Goat is being led away. He makes a mighty struggle to escape, but he is held fast by the hand that leads him. If he should effect his escape, Israel would

lose their lives. I saw that it would take time to lead away the Scape Goat into the land of forgetfulness after the sins were put on his head." Spaulding & Magan Collection, p.2

According to the above passage, the scapegoat makes a mighty struggle to escape, and if he should succeed, Israel would loose their lives. We might well inquire as to the meaning of this. How does Satan try to effect his escape? How is he held from escaping? Why would Israel lose their lives if he did escape? These are profound questions for which we need to find answers.

First of all, leading away the scapegoat is not a physical struggle. It is symbolic. But it will be understood by anyone who has ever tried to lead a billy goat to go where he didn't want to go. He will have some appreciation of the difficulty involved in the spiritual struggle to lead away the scapegoat. In the Inspired passage quoted above, we have a time frame for this climactic event. It takes place during the time of the plagues. This is also the time of Jacob's trouble for God's people. As we read in Inspiration what is going on at this time, we find Satan trying his utmost to cause the sealed saints to turn from their loyalty to God. If he could get even one of them to sin, he would win a great victory in his opposition to God's government. Satan has, from the beginning, charged God with giving a law which no one can keep. He claimed that his prin-

ciple of freedom from law was superior to God's principles. When Jesus came in fallen humanity and lived out a life of perfect obedience, Satan's saw that his charge that the law could not be perfectly obeyed was disproved. However, Satan has persistenly argued that Christ was divine, that He didn't really come in our fallen nature, and because He was exempt from our heredity, he could render that kind of perfect obedience which fallen man cannot do. This is the argument echoed by many theologians today. This is the challenge that Satan keeps throwing at God. But God has enlisted the help of man to refute Satan's claim.

Through Isaiah God has revealed His purpose to enlist the help of His people to vindicate Him. "This people have I formed for myself; they shall show forth my praise." Isaiah 43:21. Also in 5T 746 we read, "Just before us is the closing struggle of the great controversy when, with 'all power and signs and lying wonders, and with all deceivableness of unrighteousness,' Satan is to work to mis-

represent the character of God, that he may 'seduce, if it were possible, even the elect.' If there was ever a people in need of constantly increasing light from heaven, it is the people that, in this time of peril, God has called to be the depositaries of His holy law and to vindicate His character before the world." 5T 746. Through the 144,000 God is going to disprove Satan's allegations against His law. In fact, He will disprove it 144,000 times. The 144,000 obviously have no pre-existent divinity, yet not one of them will yield to Satan's devices, even under the most discouraging circumstances during the time of trouble. They will be

His prime exhibit before the onlooking universe that fallen humanity can, through the atonement provided, perfectly obey God's law.

And that is not all. Their loyalty also proves another point against Satan's kingdom. The 144,000 have tasted of Satan's kingdom and have understood by experience the pleasures of sin and all its enticements. But they have forsaken the service of Satan to become children of God. They have received all the benefits of Christ's redeeming grace, and have tasted of the pleasures of His kingdom. If they were to go back to the service of Satan, it would be a testimony to the whole universe that Satan's kingdom is preferrable to God's kingdom. This would bring great dishonor upon God's kingdom. But none of the 144,000 ever go back into Satan's ranks. In fact, they would rather

die than return to the ranks of evil, and thus they prove for all time that the service of God is infinitely better than the service of Satan.

Another vital issue is resolved by the steadfastness of the 144,000. They prove that the redemption which Christ has provided is an eternal antidote to the recurrence of sin. They have experienced all that which was typified in the sanctuary service; repentance and forgiveness in the outer court; sanctification and victory in the first apartment; and finally the blotting out of the knowledge of evil and the reception of the fulness of the Holy Spirit in the most holy place. If, after having received all the benefits of salvation, they were to fall into sin again, the whole plan of redemption would be proven a failure, and the security of the universe would be in jeopardy. The scapegoat would escape and Israel would lose their lives. By continuing to live sinlessly perfect lives, even under such adverse circumstances and duress during the time of trouble, they demonstrate

beyond a doubt that Christ's redemption is an everlasting cure against another apostasy.

God's great, over-riding purpose in His dealing with the great controversy is the eternal security of the universe against another apostasy while continuing to give to all intelligent beings freedom of choice. God has promised that "affliction shall not rise up the second time." Nahum 1:9.

But what assurance does the onlooking universe have that none of the resurrected ones will start another defection in the ages to come? How can they be confident that sin will not raise its ugly head once again? They have seen many sinners who, like the thief on the cross, accepted the Saviour in the last moments of life. How secure will they be from going back into sin again? In the 144,000, God will provide all the answers and assurances. After seeing the last drama of the great controversy played out during the time of trouble, and seeing such steadfast loyalty from the 144,000 who once were sinners like all the rest of the redeemed still sleeping in their graves, the whole loyal universe will be truly convinced that "affliction will not rise up the second time."

Now we can better understand why only the sins that were confessed while Christ was in the most holy place were placed on the scapegoat at the close of Christ's work in the sanctuary. The fit man must first succeed in leading the scapegoat away into the wilderness of this world, bearing only the sins of the 144,000 and those who

died since 1844 before the sealing took place. If the scape-goat should effect his escape, he would not only be free from the sins of the 144,000 and those who died under the giving of the Three Angel's Messages, but he would also cease to be responsible for the sins of God's people who have died through the ages before 1844. All of God's Israel would lose their lives because Satan's original charge that God's law cannot be kept would be proven right and the plan of redemption would be proven a failure.

When it has been proven that the redemption of Christ is an eternal antidote to sin, the general harvest of sleeping saints will be raised and taken to their glorious reward. It will be evident that if 144,000 fully redeemed sinners have remained loyal and true in spite of the fierce temptations of Satan in this dismal world during the time of trouble, then certainly the fully redeemed sinners who are resurrected and transported to the heavenly world where there is no curse and no tempter will remain loyal and true

for all eternity.



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
JOHN TRIPLETT

Nuts are Part of the Original Diet

rains, fruits, nuts, and vegetables constitute the diet chosen for us by our Creator. These foods, prepared in as simple and natural a manner as possible, are the most healthful and nourishing. They impart a strength, a power of endurance, and a vigor of intellect, that are not afforded by a more complex and stimulating diet. -Counsels on Diet and Foods, p. 363 (CDF 363)

In grains, fruits, vegetables, and nuts are to be found all the food elements that we need. If we will come to the Lord in simplicity of mind, He will teach us how to prepare wholesome food free from the taint of flesh meat. - CDF 363

Balance Needed in Quantity of Nuts Used

od has given us an ample variety of healthful foods, and each person should choose from it the things that experience and sound judgment prove to be best suited to his own necessities.

Nature's abundant supply of fruits, nuts, and grains is ample, and year by year the products of all lands are more generally distributed to all, by the increased facilities for transportation....

Nuts and nut foods are coming largely into use to take the place of flesh meats. With nuts may be combined grains, fruits, and some roots, to make foods that are healthful and nourishing. Care should be taken, however, not to use too large a proportion of nuts. Those who realize ill effects from the use of nut foods may find the difficulty removed by attending to this precaution. - CDF 363-4

Much time should be spent in learning how to prepare nut foods. But care should be taken no to reduce the bill of fare to a few articles, using little else than the nut foods. The majority of our people cannot obtain the nut preparations; few know how to prepare them properly for use, even if they could buy them. - CDF 364

The foods used should correspond to the climate. Some foods suitable for one country would not do at all in another place. And the nut foods should be made as inexpensive as possible, so that they can be procured by the poor. - CDF 364

areful attention should be given to the proper use of nut foods. Some kinds of nuts are not J so wholesome as others. Do not reduce the bill of fare to a few articles composed largely of nut foods. These foods should not be used too freely. If they were used more sparingly by some, the results would be more satisfactory. As combined in large proportions with other articles in some of the recipes given, they make the food so rich that the system cannot properly assimilate it. -CDF 364 623

I have been instructed that the nut foods are often used unwisely, that too large a proportion of nuts is used, that some nuts are not as wholesome as others. Almonds are preferable to peanuts; but peanuts, in limited quantities, may be used in connection with grains to make nourishing and digestible food. - CDF 364

Tell them that the time will soon come when there will be no safety in using eggs, milk, cream, or butter, because disease in animals is increasing in proportion to the increase of wickedness among men. Sweet Nut Milk

1 quart

water

2/3 cup clean, raw cashew

or almonds

pitted dates

½ tsp 1/4 tsp

salt vanilla

Process all ingredients in a blender with about 1 cup of the water until very smooth. Pour into a pitcher and stir in remaining water. Strain, if desired. Cover and refrigerate. Shake well before using. This milk is excellent on cereal and for cooking. Yields 1 quart.

VARIATIONS: (1) For Grain Milk, add 1 cup cooked millet or brown rice and process until smooth; (2) Substitute 1 tablespoon honey or 1/3 cup coconut for dates.

Nut Raisin Spread

1 cup	almonds
1 cup	roasted cashews
1 Tbsp	fresh lemon juice
½ tsp	ground coriander
1 cup	orange juice
1 cup	raisins

Process nuts in a blender or food processor for 3-5 minutes, or until a paste forms. Mix in lemon juice and coriander. Add orange juice and raisins and continue processing until well mixed. Yields 2 1/4 cups or 18 2-Tbsp servings.

Stir Emes Gel into water and heat, stirring constantly, until Emes Gel is dissolved and liquid is clear. Process in a blender with remaining ingredients until very smooth. Let stand a few minutes so that air bubbles can escape. Pour into a container and chill, covered. Keeps about 1 week. May be frozen and then heated in microwave to obtain smooth texture. Yields 1 1/4 cups or 20 servings.

* Simmer 2-3 tablespoons millet grain in ½ cup salted water for 45-60 minutes.

VARIATIONS: (1) For Garlic Butter, add garlic powder or garlic cloves, to taste; (2) for Orange Butter, add orange flavoring and honey, to taste; (3) Substitute cornmeal for millet—mix ½ cup cornmeal and ½ cup cold water. Gradually stir in 1 cup boiling water. Simmer for 20 minutes.

Per 1 tablespoon serving: 8 calories; 0.2g protein (11%), 1g carbohydrates (46%); 0.4g fat (44%); 50mg sodium; 1mg calcium; 0 mg cholesterol.

Adventism and the Creation Message

he professor of evolution called me into hsi office and I was apprehensive. he informed me that the faculty of zoology had been discussing my case, and that while they realized that it was my own business what I believed, it was their duty to see that they did not grant a Ph.D. to someone who was not a scientist. He wanted to know about my belief in creation. I told him that while I could see how one might follow an evolutionary pattern of thought, I had certain problems when I went down that pathway. He was interested. I listed to him a number of scientific problems with evolution including the fact that when one goes down into the rocks to find the fossil evolutionary ancestors of the turtle, none are found. The turtle is a very unique organism that would be expected to leave many intermediates as its systems gradually changed from an assumed lizard type of ancestor to a fully evolved turtle. Many thousands of fossil turtles have been found, one over 10 feet long, but the many evolutionary intermediates expected are notoriously absent. Did the turtle evolve, or was it created? The professor admitted to me that there were some problems with evolution, and seemed satisfied with my scientific approach. This incident well illustrates the ongoing battle being waged between science and the Bible. I was later informed that the only reason I

was allowed to graduate, was that the faculty of zoology, some 30 strong, could not agree as to what to do with me! I thank the Lord that I was able to complete my studies at that respected institution.

THE WARFARE

The controversy between the Bible and science is one of the fiercest intellectual battles of all time. It has been especially intense during the past two centuries. The powerful scientific community strongly supports the concept that life gradually evolved by itself over billions of years. This stands in stark contrast to the biblical model of a recent creation of live on earth, by God, a few thousand years ago, in only six days. While science is highly respected the general public in the Unites States has not been that supportive of the evolutionary model. Six Gallop Polls over the last two decades (Sidebar 1) indicate that only 9-12% believe science's naturalistic evolutionary model, while 44-47% believe God created man within the last ten thousand years. Some 35-40% believe God guide in the development of life over millions of years.1 It is hard for most to believe that all the amenities of the universe that provide for life on earth and the incredible complexities we have

of God as an explanatory factor in scientific interpretations,

can probably best be explained on sociological grounds.

ADVENTISM and CREATION

The Adventist church has had more than a passing interest in the discussion. We believe that the Bible is the word of God and that God is the creator. Our most distinctive doctrine the seventh-day Sabbath, rests largely on the fact that God created in six days and rested on the seventh as recorded in Genesis and specially as declared by God

Himself during the ominous and dramatic events around Mount Sinai. There He spoke and wrote with His own finger the Ten Commandments.3 These are likely the most authoritative words from God that we have. In the fourth commandment, which is the longest of the Decalogue, God explains that He created in six days, and rested on the Seventh day; and He commands us to follow His example. It is not easy to dismiss God's plain statement that "in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested on the seventh day." This does not at all sound like the development of life over millions of years as proposed by science. Furthermore, it is not easy to read millions of years into the Genesis creation account, as some do, when each of the six days of that account is described with its own "evening" and "morning."4

The Three Angels' messages of Revelation 14, given as a warning for the last days of earth, provide further reason for Adventism's interest in creation. Part of the first angel's message is an admonition to "worship him that made heaven and

SCIENTISTS STILL BELIEVE IN GOD*

In 1916 the eminent researcher James Leuba studied the religious beliefs of American scientists. One thousand randomly selected scientists listed in American Men of Science were queried. Leuba predicted that disbelief in God would increase. In 1996, the survey was duplicated as exactly as possible, again using one thousand Scientists listed in America Men and Women of Science. Over that eight-year period there was hardly any change, as far as the scientists' beliefs in God are concerned. Proportion of belief in God in various disciplines of science varied, and there was a noted decrease in desire for immortality. God was defined as the kind of God that communicates and answers prayers. Response to the questionnaires was in the 60-70% range. Details of the questions about God and responses are given below:

earth and the sea and the fountains of water."5

The message that God is creator would seem to be particularly timely for the Adventist church, since Adventism developed just as evolution became generally accepted by the intellectual community of the western world. Probably no other idea has had such a pervasive and secular influence on mankind's thinking as evolution has. The date of 1844 is particularly meaningful to us since this is the time of the great disappointment that brought forth Adventism. But 1844 is also an important date in the history of evolution. That year there appeared in England a book entitled Vestiges of the Natural History of Creation. The title belies its heretical contents. The book caused a minor explosion in placid Victorian England.⁶ The author after analyzing fossil patterns, proposed a then shocking principle of progressive development for the life on earth, i.e. evolution. For that time, sales of the book were phenomenal. During its first ten years 24,000 copies were sold, which is more than twice as many as for Darwin's famous book Origin of the Species, also published in England 15 years later. Sales of Vestiges were enhanced by violent objections from leading thought leaders. Adam Sedgwick, the president of the Geological Society wrote a 400-page critique of this "false philosophy." Adding to the intrigue was the fact that the name of the author was kept secret because he did not dare to identify himself. It was only revealed after his death in 1871. It turned out to be the well-known Robert Chambers, the editor of Chamber's Encyclopedia.

Darwin's Origin of Species had more influence in the long run; and by the end of the century there was a general acceptance of some form of evolution by most scientists and many theologians. It has sometimes been proposed that it was no chance happenstance that the Seventh-day Adventist church, with its special Sabbath based on creation, came into existence at the same time as evolution. It has also been suggested that "God was not caught by surprise by this turn of events.8 Could it be that one of the special purposes of Adventism is to counter the secularism brought on by the acceptance of evolution? While we don't have strong evidence that the timing of the origin of Adventism was designed to coincide with the general acceptance of evolution, the idea that was, is both intriguing and plausible. Regardless, there is no question that Adventism has an especially important message for the prevailing evolutionary philosophy of our time. Adventism with its seventh-day Sabbath that honors God's six-day creation week is a special answer to ideas of millions of years of gradual evolution where it is postulated that there is no need of a God. It is hard to separate Adventism from creation. Even the first part of our name "Seventh-Day" refers to a memorial of the six-day creation week.

ADJUSTMENTS

When Charles Darwin published his Origin of Species, it was greeted with a strong but mixed reaction. Some prominent biologists especially objected to his views. However within a few decades, evolution was generally accepted, especially among scientists, and eventually among many theologians. Of special interest was a noted group at Princeton University who opposed Darwin but adopted views, of which there are many now,9 have played a prominent role in the debate. None of them agree with the biblical model of a recent creation by God in six days. These models are notably speculative, lacking any direct authentication wither from the data of nature or from the Bible. Almost all advocate that life developed over long geological ages, but that in various ways, God was somewhat involved. Crucial to the debate is the origin of the fossil bearing layers of the crust of our earth. Did they form gradually over eons or were they the result of the horrendous worldwide deluge brought on as a result of man's wickedness as described in Genesis.¹⁰ The Genesis flood is the crucial event that can reconcile the six-day creation account to the fossil record of the earth.11

Progressive Creation is one of the intermediate views closer to the biblical creation account. It proposes that life developed over millions of years, as God from time to time created more and more advanced forms of life, eventually creating man. Some advocates of this view propose that each day of creation week described in Genesis represents a very long period of time. However, the sequence of events in Genesis, where plants are created on the third

day before animals on the fifth and sixth days, does not fit the order of the geologic layers where the major groups of animals appear before almost all the major groups of plants. Probably the most serious inconsistency this model faces is that we see the effects of sin in the fossil records at a time that this model assumes to be long before the creation of humans, their fall, and the consequences of that fall on nature.¹² The Bible tells us that what God creates is "very good." How could that very good creation explain dinosaurs chewing each other up over millions of years before the arrival of sin and its aftermath? Furthermore, many thousands of important groups of fossil plants and animals are not now living on earth. Why would a kind and omniscient God create so many species over millions of years only to have them die out? The biblical model of a recent creation, the fall of humankind, the consequences of sin on nature, and the subsequent destruction by the

Theistic Evolution is another popular intermediate view between creation and evolution. Here is God closely associated with a continuous evolutionary process over millions of years. He uses evolution, and He is there to help when evolution is inadequate. The model faces the same problems mentioned for progressive creation. Also the many thousands of missing fossil intermediates between major groups of organisms strongly suggest that evolution never occurred. Furthermore it would seem strange that a loving, and omniscient God would use the crutch of evolution where only the fittest survive. The concern God has for His erring and wayward children, does not fit at all with the harsh competition and survival of only the fittest, as proposed for the evolutionary process.

Genesis flood, resolves these inconsistencies.

The recent Intelligent Design movement is a new kind of approach that aims to point to the scientific evidence for some kind of designer. It studiously avoids any reference to the Bible and religion. While its contribution to the origins debate is significant, Adventism, which upholds the Bible as the word of God, adds a much richer input to the discussion.

LESSONS FROM THE PAST

Intermediate views such as theistic evolution and progressive creation have had a significant influence on religious beliefs. The mainline Christian churches have generally accepted such concepts. Evangelical churches, that favor amore direct interpretation of Scripture, tend to have reservations about such views in various ways. It does not appear that trends towards evolutionary concepts have been especially beneficial to mainline churches. In the United States, in the last century, mainline churches have been losing members by the millions, while evangelical types of church organizations have been growing, some quite rapidly.14 Church growth is a complicated thing, and this data does not warrant the firm conclusion that the trend towards evolution is necessarily the cause of loss in membership. But the trend is away from the Bible, and does not appear to have been helpful for either growth or the spread of the gospel of salvation.

In order to accommodate the Bible to a variety of other ideas about our origins, it is often suggested that the first eleven chapters of Genesis, which includes the accounts of creation and the flood, are allegorical and not factual history. The problem with that interpretation is that the leading biblical personalities do not treat the creation and flood accounts as allegorical. Many, including Peter, Paul, Christ, and even God¹⁵ authenticate the factuality of creation and the flood. It would be a strange kind of God who would create over millions of years, and then ask us to keep the seventh-day Sabbath holy because he created all in six days! When the Creator of the universe makes a plain statement of fact, who are we, to put a question mark after it.

Drifting away from God's words is a pattern that occurred frequently in Old Testament times. More recently, mainline churches have drifted away from their original beliefs in the Bible. In the last two centuries, many of the leading educational institutions in the United States (such as Auburn University, Boston University, Brown, Dartmouth, Harvard, Princeton, Rutgers, the University of Southern California, Wesleyan University, Wichita State University, and Yale) that began as church related religious institutions, have abandoned their religious foundations and become

independent secular institutions.

I do not know of any such institutions that began as secular and then became religious. The philosophy of education is now strongly secular. In some of these institutions we now find the leading evolutionary authorities of the world. Adventism needs to be especially careful that the pressures that have caused other churches and institutions to drift away from the Bible and God do not affect us.

THE OPPORTUNITIES

It could be argued that the trend towards evolution and secularization is a trend towards truth. Science has

proved its value and we might as well follow it. However, this argument cannot be easily sustained. While some scientific interpretations challenge the Bible, the past two decades of scientific investigation have not been kind to evolution.

Discoveries in three major areas challenge traditional scientific evolutionary interpretations.

(1) The recent discoveries in molecular biology present complexities of integrated and feedback mechanisms that thwart any idea that these could have just happened by chance. Thus far evolutionists have not been able to produce a workable model for the development of complexity. (Sidebar 3). It appears that there has to be an intelligent mind behind all this. (2) A number of physical constants

related to matter and the universe are exactly what they should be to make the universe habitable for life. Even every slight deviation could spell cosmic annihilation.¹⁷ This is very precise design.

(3) The new trend in Geology towards **Excerpts:** rapid catastrophic interpretations, which From chapter "The God of our Salvation" has been labeled as "great philosophical breakthrough"¹⁸ fits in well with what would be expected from the Genesis flood of the Bible.19

Adventism has a special opportunity here. We believe that the Bible is the Word of God. We believe that God is our Creator and that He has the ability to recreate us at the resurrection. We have a seventh-day Sabbath that witnesses to our belief in creation. The opportunities before us are unprecedented. The world needs to know that the Bible is the Word of God and that God is the Creator. Our message provides healing for the skepticism, relativism, agnosticism, and nihilism that is so prevalent now. Above all, the world needs to know about the faithful and forgiving God of the Bible that is doing all possible for the salvation of all.

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
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
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
