The Hebrew Pentateuch in a Hebrew Lodge, and the Koran in a Mohammedan one, belong on the Altar; and one of these, and the Square and Compass, properly understood, are the Great Lights by which a Mason must walk and work.

Thus by the lure of Paradise the Assassins enlisted instruments for their criminal work and established a system of organized murder on a basis of religious fervour.

Nothing is true and all is allowed was the ground of their secret doctrine, which, however, being imparted but to few and concealed under the veil of the most austere religions and piety, restrained the mind under the yoke of blind obedience.

Dorothy J. Gaiter, "Former NAACP Director Chavis Says He is Joining Farrakhan's Nation of Islam," *The Wall Street Journal* (February 24, 1997): B9:

He stated that his ministry "has always been ecumenical and interfaith. There is a linkage between Judaism, Christianity and Islam and I believe that there should be a great trialogue, not a dialogue, but a trialogue between these three great revealed religions." In 1997 he "announced he is converting to Islam and becoming a member of Rev. Louis Farrakhan's Nation of Islam." He claims that he still believes in Jesus Christ but he "expects his announcement to shock many of his Christian friends and fellow members of the clergy..."

He also insists that he really hasn't changed. He states: "If you pour water from one glass to another glass, the composition of the water is the same. I am who I am..." "And there is but one God. The God of Judaism is the God of Christianity is the God of Islam. So if we all serve the same God why can't we all work together?"
