Pope Pius XII affirmed strongly the queenship of Mary, He established a special liturgical feast called "Mary Queen of Heaven." He consecrated the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Mother and Queen, on October 31, 1942. In the special prayer he said "As the Church and the entire human race were consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus...so we in like manner consecrate ourselves forever also to you and your Immaculate Heart, our mother and queen of the world.

Act of Consecration
to the Immaculate Heart of Mary
(St. Louis de Montfort's Consecration)


"I, N., a faithless sinner — renew and ratify today in thy hands, O Immaculate Mother, the vows of my Baptism; I renounce forever Satan, his pomps and works; and I give myself entirely to Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Wisdom, to carry my cross after Him all the days of my life, and to be more faithful to Him than I have ever been before.


"In the presence of all the heavenly court I choose thee this day for my Mother and Mistress. I deliver and consecrate to thee, as thy slave, my body and soul, my goods, both interior and exterior, and even the value of all my good actions, past, present and future; leaving to thee the entire and full right of disposing of me, and all that belongs to me, without exception, according to thy good pleasure, for the greater glory of God, in time and in eternity. Amen."

Six Dialogues on the Lord's Day: 23:

Sunday being the day on which the Gentiles solemnly adored that planet...The Christians thought fit to keep the same day and the same name of it, that they might not appear causelessly peevish, and by that means hinder the conversion of the Gentiles.

Webster's Disctionary (1929):

Sunday—so called because this day was anciently dedicated to the sun, or to its worship. The first day of the week.

Catholic World (1929): 809:

The sun was a foremost god with heathendom...hence the church...would seem to have said, 'Keep that old pagan name. It shall remain consecrated, sanctified,' and thus the pagan Sunday, dedicated to Balder, became the Christian Sunday, sacred to Jesus.
