

H. Grattan Guinness, *Romanism and the Reformation* (1887: 105):

Here we have a point on which Paul affirms existence of knowledge in the Christian Church. The early church knew, he says, what the hindrance was. The early church tells us what it did know upon the subject, and no one in these days can be in a position to contradict its testimony as to what Paul had said by word of mouth only...told the Thessalonians. It is a point on which ancient tradition alone can have authority. Modern speculation is positively impertinent on such a subject.




...While the Caesars held imperial power, it was impossible for the predicted antichrist to arise. On the fall of the Caesars he would arise.

Tertullian, *On the Resurrection* (200 AD: chapters 24 and 25):

...he who hinders must now be taken out of the way. What obstacle is there but the Roman State; The falling away of which, by being scattered into ten kingdoms, shall introduce antichrist...

John Chrysostom, *Homily on 2 Thessalonians 2* (390 AD):

“Only there is one who restraineth now, until he be taken out of the way, that is when the Roman Empire is taken away, then he [Antichrist] shall come.”



Edward B. Elliot, *Commentary on the Apocalypse volume 3* (1862: 92):

We have the consenting testimony of the early fathers, from Irenaeus, the disciple of St. John, down to Chrysostom and Jerome, to the effect that it was understood to be the imperial power ruling and residing at Rome.

Ron Thompson, *Champions of Christianity in Search of the Truth* (1196: 47):

Paul did not identify the restraining power which they knew to be Rome, for fear of reprisals. Remember, the Christian Church was under persecution by Rome.

Other Churches are no sisters of ours, the Vatican insists...

Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger [who became Pope Benedict XVI], said it was incorrect to call Christian churches, ranging from Protestant to Orthodox, “sister churches” of the Catholic Church.

The Cardinal said the term was “sloppy terminology” and could not be used to describe Christian communities that were not actually in communion with Rome. “It must be always clear that the one, holy, catholic and apostolic universal church is not the sister, but the mother of all the churches.”

Gary Kah, *En Route to Global Occupation* (Huntington House Publishers, 1992): 193-195:

On September 17, 1973, the Club of Rome published a special, highly confidential report called the 'Regionalized and Adaptive Model of the Global World System, which was sent to the power elite to be implemented. This document reveals that the Club has divided the world into ten political/economic regions, which it refers to as 'kingdoms' a designation that tracks eerily with the terminology used in the Book of Revelation, Chapter 13:1-2. In 1974 the authors of the report, Mihaljo Mesarovic and Edward Pestel published their findings in a book Mankind at the Turning Point. However, in this book, which is intended for public consumption, they have dropped the word 'kingdom.'


