



For several centuries after the establishment of Christianity, baptism was conferred by immersion, but since the twelfth century the practice of baptizing by infusion has prevailed in the Catholic church, as this manner is attended with less inconvenience than Baptism by immersion (James Cardinal Gibbons, The faith of our Fathers, 110th. Ed. P. 277).
